MINUTES

Also on the videoconference were Associate Directors Deborah Klein Lopez and Dennis Washburn (joined at 6:50 p.m.), Executive Officer Clark Stevens, Finance & Operations Officer John Hendra and Senior Conservation Biologist Rosi Dagit (exited at 7:00 p.m.).
- 2. INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS: Glenn Bailey, RCD representative to the Sepulveda Basin Wildlife Area Steering Committee (SBWASC).

3. PUBLIC COMMENTS:

- Mr. Bailey reported that the SBWASC is having a special meeting tomorrow to discuss pesticide use in the Sepulveda Basin. He requested that somebody attend from the RCD who has a better understanding of the RCD's position on this issue.
